



SUPPLY TEACHER POSTING **for Early Childhood Teachers and Grade School**

SCOPE OF THE POSITION: Parent & Child, Preschool, Kindergarten, and Grades 1 to 8,

Supply teaching may be arranged in advance by individual teachers, or on the morning of the day needed (after 6:30 AM). Generally, teachers will be asking for half-day or full day coverage.

All Supply Teachers need:

- Current Police Check, including the Vulnerable Sector Check
- Experience and confidence with positive behaviour management

Grade School Supply Teachers should have a Bachelor of Education Degree **OR** other relevant experience working with Grade School age children (e.g. coaching, theatre, tutoring, etc.).

Early Childhood Assistant Supply Teachers should have a Bachelor of Education Degree, Early Childhood Education Diploma **OR** other relevant experience working with or caring for young children (e.g. child care, parenting, etc.).

Supply Teachers will:

- Follow the school's Code of Conduct: respecting self, others, and the environment
- Follow our Guidelines for Supply Teachers
- Follow the Confidentiality and Conduct Agreement
- Create a warm and nurturing environment for children with clear, consistent boundaries

COMPENSATION: The rates for Supply Teaching are:

- Lead Teacher Coverage: \$19.57/hour including 4% vacation pay
- Assistant Teacher Coverage: \$18.20/hour including 4% vacation pay
