



POSTING - Morning Garden Preschool Teacher

Mulberry Waldorf School is inviting applications for our Morning Garden Preschool Program with a possible January start.

SCOPE OF THE POSITION: Morning Garden Preschool Teachers are responsible for leading, planning and delivering a Waldorf preschool program for children ages 3-4 years old using Mulberry Waldorf School's best practices. The Morning Garden Preschool program is licensed under the Childcare and Early Years Act (CCEYA). The core program runs five mornings with afternoon care options.

KEY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE POSITION: The ideal candidates will have training and/or experience in Waldorf education and working with young children and their families. In addition, the following qualifications are required:

- Registered Early Childhood Educator
- Relevant Childcare and Early Years Act knowledge and experience
- Ability to work collaboratively with colleagues
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills with children, colleagues and parents
- Ability to create a warm and gentle environment for young children
- Experience and confidence with positive behaviour management
- Musical and artistic abilities, such as storytelling, puppetry and circle work
- Recent Police Check (including a vulnerable sector check) and CPR-First Aid training as well as up to date immunization records

COMPENSATION: Salary is determined based on the percentage of the position, qualifications and experience. The current hourly rate for a lead position is \$18.82/hour. The current hourly rate for an assistant position is \$17.50/hour. Vacation pay of 4% is added to these hourly rates.

ABOUT MULBERRY: Mulberry Waldorf School, established in 1996, offers programs for students and their parents from birth through Grade Eight. We are located within an active downtown community in beautiful and historic Kingston, with access to local parks, waterfront, conservation areas and provincial parks.
